



TYPBC Single handed Racing Declaration 2019-20

All participants who sail single-handed in any Keeler, Trailer yacht or Multi-hull race run by the TYPBC or who compete in the TYPBC single-handed race, are required to complete and return the following declaration before starting :

I declare that:

1. I will carry **on my person** the means to self-initiate a 3rd party rescue in the event that I become unable to sail single handed or fall overboard.

Appropriate equipment would include marine communications equipment such as a waterproof handheld VHF marine radio, a cell phone in in a dry container that can be operated while being kept dry, or a registered 406 MHz marine EPIRB/PLB. A whistle, light, or signalling mirror may be carried, but will not meet the requirement of this rule.

2. I **will wear** an approved personal flotation device at all times while racing.
3. I will make myself and my vessel available for safety inspections immediately before or after the race.
4. My vessel carries the safety equipment listed in rule 17 of the TYPBC General Sailing Instructions.
5. I participate in the race entirely at my own risk and accept that TYPBC is not liable for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained before, during the course of, or after the race.
